NEW BC BUILDING CODE REGULATIONS

The BC government has announced new BC Building Code (BCBC) 2024 provisions for adaptable dwellings and seismic design in effect Monday, March 10, 2025, with adaptable-dwelling requirements being gradually implemented. The adaptable-dwelling requirements will be introduced in a phased approach, starting at 20% of units in large residential buildings, as opposed to the previously proposed 100%. Projects where design work began before March 8, 2024, may continue to follow the 2018 BC Building Code, provided they apply for a building permit before March 8, 2027. Projects for which a building permit will be applied for on or after March 10, 2025, must comply with the BCBC 2024, including the seismic-design and adaptable-dwelling provisions.

Attached are bulletins outlining the transition periods in more detail.
